

Patients We Cannot Treat

- Seizure within last 12 months.
- Blood Clot/Deep Vein Thrombosis within last 12 months.
- Patients are actively diagnosed with cancer, not in remission. (exclude skin cancer)
- Patients receiving chemotherapy/immunotherapy treatment.
(cannot treat syringe/port injection however pills are acceptable)
- Patients with open wounds near the treatment area.
- Patients with a pacemaker or implantable cardioverter-defibrillator (ICD).
- Patients with a bladder or spinal stimulator that cannot be turned off.
- Patients with metallic implants (rods, screws, or plates) near the treatment area.
- We do not treat patients in the face/head, heart, or groin/buttocks area.
